- attend application office hours with current students
- virtually visit research labs and tour the Ohio State campus

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- must be currently studying or living in the U.S.
- 3.0 GPA (cumulative)
- rising junior or senior in undergraduate program OR
- currently enrolled in a masters program
