# **News and Updates**

## Bureau of Early Intervention Releases a Revised Provider Handbook

On December 1, 2016, the Bureau of Early Intervention released a Revised <u>Illinois Early</u> <u>Intervention Provider Handbook (PDF)</u>. This handbook replaces the *Early Intervention Service Descriptions, Billing* Codes *and Rates* document.

Perhaps your first thought was "Oh no, what changes have been made?" or maybe it was something more along the lines of "thank goodness, it needed to be updated." The good news is that the revised provider handbook is here and it contains a wealth of information for anyone supporting families in Illinois' EI system. The first thing you may notice is that the Handbook begins with a Welcome and overview of the Principles of Early Intervention and the beliefs that guide our work in Illinois' EI System.

#### You might be wondering what you need to know right away; here are a few things to know:

- The revised handbook is the result of input from providers, CFC personnel, IICEI members, Bureau staff, and the Illinois EI Partners (CBO, Provider Connections, EITP, Monitoring, and Clearinghouse).
- The Bureau's goal is to review this annually to ensure accuracy and consistency.
- You can begin implementing immediately, but implementation is required as of February 1, 2017.
- Mostly what you will find is clarification or expanded information on topics, policies and procedures.
- There are some additions and changes you will want to pay close attention to (for example, DTH and global assessment, 6 month and discharge report formats, nursing evaluations, guidance on child outcomes summary process)
- EITP is collecting questions and requests for clarification through a discussion board.

#### Next steps you can take:

- 1. Review the revised Provider Handbook in its entirety and note any questions you have or areas for which you need further clarification.
- 2. Participate in the EITP Provider Handbook webinar on 12/16/16 at 1:00pm for an overview of the Provider Handbook.
- 3. Submit any questions or needs for clarification on the open Provider Handbook Discussion Board (see instructions below)
- 4. Communicate with colleagues in your local area through upcoming LIC meetings or provider meetings.
- 5. Watch for future newsletters to highlight and discuss specific pieces of the Provider Handbook

# **SSIP Updates**

## State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) Workgroup Updates

- The Leadership Teams in Aurora, East St. Louis and Williamson County had their first meetings in November and are currently completing their Benchmarks of Quality and crafting action plans specific to their communities. They received a variety of resources that have been developed by the various SSIP workgroups and had their first train-the-trainer event in December, focused on the Child Outcomes Summary Process. The Leadership teams are meeting regularly as part of the SSIP Implementation Phase and evaluation measures are being put in place to ensure feedback loops and continuous improvement cycles to make adjustments as progress is reviewed.
- The revised Provider Handbook has been released and contains a new section with more in-depth information about child outcomes. Implementation with fidelity of the Child Outcomes Summary (COS) Process is one of the two identified coherent improvement strategies in the SSIP so you will see a strong statewide focus and effort on child outcomes.
- State staff attended a **meeting in Dallas with TA providers and other states** to support our understanding and implementation of the State Systemic Improvement Plan according to OSEP expectations.
- The **Messaging Group**, made up of a diverse group of stakeholders, continues it work to develop a messaging rubric to be used with all El materials in an effort to ensure consistent messages across all El materials. They have also been working on revising the El brochure, "Do You Have Questions About Your Child's Development?"

Looking for SSIP updates? EITP has a resource page focused on the <u>State Systematic Improvement Plan (SSIP)</u> to help the field stay up-to-date on news and information related to the important work being done relating to the SSIP.





Additionally, there is a new EITP Online Training: Illinois State Systemic Improvement Plan. This training allows participants to learn more about the Illinois SSIP for El credit (1.0 hour in Working with Families). This short presentation provides highlights from Phase 1 of the Plan, describes the work completed during Phase 2, and outlines what will be occurring during Phase 3. Also discussed are the identified coherent improvement strategies, partners involved, supports for implementation and goals of the evaluation plan.
