SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your interest in the McNelley Music Scholarship. Applicants must be **women** who have at least **sophomore** standing at the time of application and have at least **one semester of studies to complete** before graduating. The scholarship funds are for the 2021-2022 academic year and will be paid to the university.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

1. The **<u>current</u>** P.E.O. McNelley Music Scholarship Application form:

- Must be typed or printed legibly
- ALL blanks <u>must</u> be filled in
- If an item is not applicable, indicate this by entering "NA"
- Your Student ID Number or Enrollment Number is essential to meet Federal Eligibility Requirements
- Please use another email address other than .edu
- 2. A typed 600 word or less personal narrative
- Insight into you as a person:
 - Influences leading to your chosen career
 - Your interests, talents, and hobbies
 - Previous experience in or exposure to your chosen career
 - Your career objectives
 - $\circ \quad \text{Your educational goals} \\$
- 3. ONE (1) reference from current Music Faculty...<u>no emails accepted.</u>

4. ONE (1) current official school transcript.

START EARLY

- Request your supportive documents (transcript and one current faculty reference) as soon as possible:
 - Helps ensure you will receive those documents in time to mail your application packet prior to <u>March 1</u>
 - <u>Submissions received with a later than March 1 postmark or incomplete</u> <u>applications will not be considered</u>

McNelley Music Scholarship Information – FAQ

The McNelley family asked the P.E.O. Foundation to administer an annual Music Scholarships to be awarded to women studying music at a Big 10 University with a Music Department. Since August of 2012, the Scholarship Selection Committee has been managing, receiving, and choosing a recipient on an annual basis.

How does one apply for the scholarship?

Scholarship applications and instruction sheets are available at <u>scholarships@peoiowa.org</u> or may be available at the Big 10 Music Departments. P.E.O. Chapters can notify qualified applicants encouraging them to apply, but have no part in nominating applicants as it is not a State or International Project.

When is the application period?

One envelope containing the following: McNelley Application form, 600 word or less Personal Narrative, one current Music Faculty Reference and Official Transcripts of the nominee <u>must be postmarked no later than</u> **March 1** and mailed to the Vice Chair of the Scholarship Selection Committee; please see name of Vice Chair on Scholarship Application Instructions.

When is the scholarship awarded?

The Scholarship Selection Committee reviews and selects the recipient and forwards a written report to the Iowa State Executive Board for ratification at the Spring Board Meeting. The award will be announced during the business meeting at the Convention of Iowa State Chapter in June. The recipient and the applicants not selected will also be notified by the Scholarship Selection Committee Vice Chair.

What are the qualifications for a nominee?

- 1. Be a woman currently enrolled in a Music Program at a Big 10 University with a Music Department.
- 2. Be a full time student majoring in Instrumental or Choral Music including Composition, Performance, Education, Theory or History.
- 3. Be a sophomore or higher standing at the time of application and having at least one semester to complete before graduation.
- 4. Demonstrate academic excellence, maturity, and a seriousness of purpose.

What are the selection criteria?

- Influences leading to chosen career
- Future Goals and career objectives
- School Involvement
- Character, interests, talents, and hobbies
- Scholarship
- Previous experience in or exposure to your career chose
