Who we are: Hickey Bros. Research, LLC is a private fisheries research company. The company's foundation is in the Wisconsin commercial fishery and was established in 1967. The research division later developed, drawing on the knowledge and expertise obtained from commercial fishing on Lake Michigan & Bay of Green Bay.
