Fellows interview staff and review key documents to finalize the project scope and the "gap" they will support.



VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT

In parallel with their project, Fellows support increased volunteerism in the region.



SERVICE PROJECTS

Based on the gap assessment results, Fellows implement a specific capacity-building project.



TRANSITIONING EXPERTISE

Fellows provide training to staff and/or share results with key stakeholders to sustain progress.

BENEFITS

QUALIFICATIONS

AmeriCorps Requirements

- Be a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident of the US
- Ability to pass FBI, CA DOJ, out-of-state (if applicable),

and NSOPR background checks prior to service

CivicSpark Requirements

- Minimum of a 2-year AA degree from an accredited college or university
- Commitment to the full term of service (7.5 months)
