

# 2023 Summer Fawning Research Technician



**What?** Fieldwork will include conducting radio telemetry and opportunistically searching for white-tailed fawns to capture and install VHF collars and take morphological measurements. Radio telemetry will be used to track and identify mortality events.

**Who?** Enthusiastic and motivated individuals who have or are working towards a degree in Biology or a related field. Applicants are required to have a valid driver's license and must be willing to work in harsh conditions.



**The details:** Starting salary \$14/hr for a maximum of 37.5 hrs/week. Fieldwork will be conducted around Lake Shelbyville, IL (near Sullivan, IL) with housing provided. The position starts May 15, 2023 and continues through July 1, 2023.
