Fisheries Aide



One, full-time, seasonal position in the Fisheries Division is located at **Glen Elder Reservoir**, Mitchell County, KS and directly supervised by Scott Waters, District Fisheries Biologist.

Details:

Employment will be from the end of the Spring Semester until the beginning of the Fall Semester. The position will work 40 hours per week in a field setting. Some office work required. Housing not provided.

Duties:

- Independently track ultrasonically-tagged walleye and blue catfish at Glen Elder Reservoir
- Operate ½ ton pickup and trailer with a variety of boats.
- Assistance with standardized and supplemental fish population sampling
- Building & deploying fish habitat constructed from trees and synthetic materials (chainsaw work required)
- Assistance with youth fishing programs (*requires occasional weekends*)
- Fish stockings
- Public fishing lake patrol and sign maintenance
- Storage building maintenance and cleaning
- Equipment and fish net repair/maintenance
- Other duties as assigned



Starting Salary: \$10.50/hr

Minimum Requirements: Currently enrolled in a natural resource program from an accredited University. Preference will be given to those that are enrolled in a fish and/or wildlife field of study. Must have a valid driver's license. Must be willing to work occasional nights & weekends.
