

3. offer advice relevant to crime and fear abatement, law enforcement, public safety, and emergency preparedness;
4. actively support measures that enhance the foundation of safety and security on which the university was established; and
5. empower the public in the spirit of community-oriented public safety to assist the University of Illinois Division of Public Safety in their endeavor to better serve the campus community.

The first meeting of the 2016-2017 academic year will be held on Tuesday, September 29, 2016 at 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in conference rooms 133-134 at the Illinois Fire Service Institute, 11 Gerty Drive, Champaign.
