### <u>Who can vote?</u>

- US citizens who are at least 18 years old
- Can students vote in Champaign-Urbana? YES!!

#### What if I'm not registered to vote here in C-U?

No problem! You can register to vote or change your voting address when you go to vote. If you are a first-time voter or need to change any of your voting information, you should bring a picture ID (your I-Card is fine) and a piece of mail with your current address (you can use your University of Illinois Residence Hall assignment, paper or digital, current semester). Voter registration cards are not needed to vote.

#### Why vote (here in Champaign-Urbana)?

- This is where you live most of the year and decisions here will impact you.
- Politicians pay attention to students if students vote (and don't if they don't)!
- There are important races that could be decided by a few votes and will impact students for years.

## <u>What is on the ballot this year?</u>

- US Congressional Representative & US Senator
- Governor/Lieutenant Governor
- State Senator & State Representative
- County Clerk (decides how easy it will be for students to vote in the Presidential election.)
- State constitutional amendment regarding the right to collective bargaining for workers
