Check out this unique Spring 2023 class at Allen Rhetoric 105: Writing and Research: The Rhetoric of Animal Rights

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 11:00-12:15, Allen Hall

In this section of Rhetoric 105: Writing and Research, designed specifically for Unit One/Allen Hall, each student will complete a semester-long research project on a topic of their choosing. Throughout the course, we'll look at various examples of rhetorical successes and failures from the Animal Liberation movement, including materials from organizations such as the People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals, the Nonhuman Rights Project, and the Animal Legal Defense Fund. These cultural artifacts and other critical readings will give us new insights into the shifting roles that animals occupy in our society, and they'll act as a starting point to help frame and guide students' individual research projects throughout the spring.
