Screening of Kyungmook Kim's film *Stateless Things*, with discussion & reception to follow: In 2014, the Association of Korean Independent Film and Video named Kyungmook Kim the Filmmaker of the Year, and just a few months later, the Korean government imprisoned him for being a conscientious objector. Kim's works interrogate the ways in which marginalized members of Korean society (ethnic and sexual minorities, political refugees) create spaces for themselves on the borders between visibility and invisibility, presence and absence.

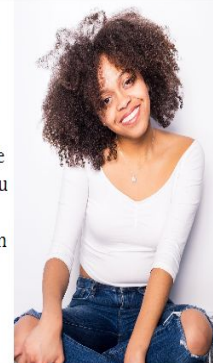
