Shing Yin Khor is a cartoonist and installation artist who is exploring personal narrative, new human rituals, and collaborative world-building through graphic memoir, science fiction, and large scale art structures. Her immersive and narrative haunted house art installations, *The Last Outpost* and *The Last Apothecary*, received grants from Burning Man for their 2014 and 2016 festivals. She recently completed another large scale science fiction-themed site-specific installation, *Salvage Station No. 8*, in conjunction with Beam Camp in New Hampshire. As a cartoonist, her work has been published in *The Toast* and *Bitch Magazine*. Her first full length graphic novel, about traveling Route 66, is published by Zest Books. She creates comics at the intersection of race, gender, immigrant stories, and queerness.

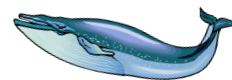
Meet the PAs

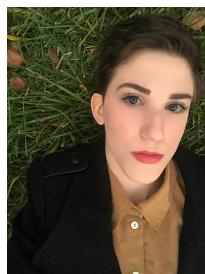
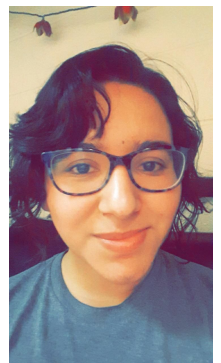
