He co-founded 3ware, a successful Silicon Valley startup; did pioneering work in Virtual Reality at VPL Research; and created the Brain Machine, one of *MAKE Magazine's* most popular DIY projects. He leads workshops around the world, teaching people to make cool things with electronics, as well as promoting hackerspaces and open source hardware. Altman is a co-founder of Noisebridge, and President and CEO of Cornfield Electronics.
