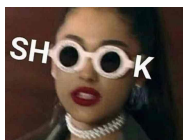

Tamer is a Palestinian rapper, actor, screenwriter, and social

activist. He is the premier voice of Palestinian hip-hop and leader of the world's first Palestinian hip-hop group DAM. He co-wrote and starred in the award-winning feature film Junction 48, inspired by his youth and early years as a rapper. Nafar reinvented hip-hop in its purest form: rage without hate, social-political awareness without empty materialism, and large audiences without selling out. Today, millions of fans worldwide follow his rap group, DAM, which has released two albums and multiple music videos. Nafar serves as a role model for young Arabs across the globe.
